## Important Information About Bitter Root Day, 2020

Because of the COVID-19 outbreak, this event will be a bit different than it has in past years. Our top priority is the health and safety of everyone and we are dedicated to providing a safe place for people to enjoy the event. We don't know what the situation will be in June so we are letting you know in advance that we may have some directives that will need to be followed to keep yourself and others safe.

These directives may include having hand sanitizer or disinfecting wipes available for your personal use throughout the day, wearing a mask and gloves, asking customers to shop and go without socializing, making sure people to keep six feet between themselves and other shoppers at your booth, and pre-bagging any food items that are for sale. We will include information in your vendor packet about what you will need to do and what to expect, which you will receive prior to the event.

New this season we will have a 30 foot long community mural, depicting our Bitter Root landscape that everyone can work on individually, then add to the overall piece. To help with maintaining social distancing and to keep everyone safe, we will have it set up so everyone can work on it separately from each other. We will also have Bitter Root flowers for sale.

We will have more updates on what activities and entertainment will be included as the warm season continues.

## Updated refund information

We have adjusted our refund policy for Bitter Root Day, 2020. If we have to cancel the event, we will issue full refunds. If, for any reason, a vendor needs to cancel booth space at any time leading up to the event, we will issue a refund, minus the processing fee of \$10.
